

## Evac Chair Training

**An Evacuation Chair is a device manufactured for a smooth descent on stairways**

The Regulatory Reform (Fire Safety) Order 2005, requires that all people using the building be provided with adequate means of escape in case of fire.

This includes a suitable escape plan for mobility impaired persons. Anyone permitted into a building must be safely evacuated in the event of an emergency without the dependence of the emergency services.

The course is designed to train key members of staff who have been given responsibility by their employer to assist in the evacuation of the mobility impaired within their premises.

***For complete safety we advise two people are present at all time to assist and open doors on the exit routes.***
